



Cervantes Society of America Graduate Student Grants

The Cervantes Society of America is pleased to announce that four graduate student grants of up to \$500 each will be awarded annually for papers presented at the MLA, RSA or any international, national, or regional conference on topics related to the life and works of Miguel de Cervantes.

Eligibility — you must meet both of the following conditions:

Current member in good standing of the Cervantes Society of America

Current graduate student

You must still be enrolled as a graduate student when the conference takes place. Graduate students who have not previously received a CSA conference grant will be given priority.

Application Materials — submit all of the following:

1. Cover page with:

- a. Name
- b. University; degree program; year within program
- c. Name of your graduate advisor
- d. Title of your conference presentation
- e. Name, date, and location of the conference
- f. Explanation of the grant's importance to your professional development

Limit 100 words.

g. Budget

Funds may be used for airfare, local transportation (trains, buses, taxis), accommodations, meals, and conference registration. Costs must be reasonable and customary.

h. Other sources of financing

List all scholarships, grants, and other subsidies at your disposal.

i. Previous CSA grants

If you have previously received a CSA graduate student grant, indicate amount(s) and year(s).

2. Documentation that your conference paper has been formally accepted

In certain circumstances, grants may be awarded pending receipt of this formal acceptance.

3. Abstract of your conference paper

Deadline for Receipt of Complete Applications — September 1, 2018

This deadline is for papers that will be presented between September 1, 2018 and August 31, 2019. Grants will not be awarded retroactively for papers presented before September 1, 2018. Successful applicants will normally be notified by November 1. Reimbursements will be made after the conference has taken place and upon submission of receipts.
